Frankfort – James Walter “Jamie” Yount, Jr., age 54, passed away on Friday, October 9, 2020. Graveside services will be held at Camp Nelson National Cemetery on Thursday, October 15, 2020, at 11:00 a.m. with Rev. Jeff Eaton officiating. Military Honors will be observed by the VFW Post 4075.
