Frankfort – Ms. Barbara Ann (Greene) Brown, age 82, passed away at home on Tuesday, July 30, 2019. 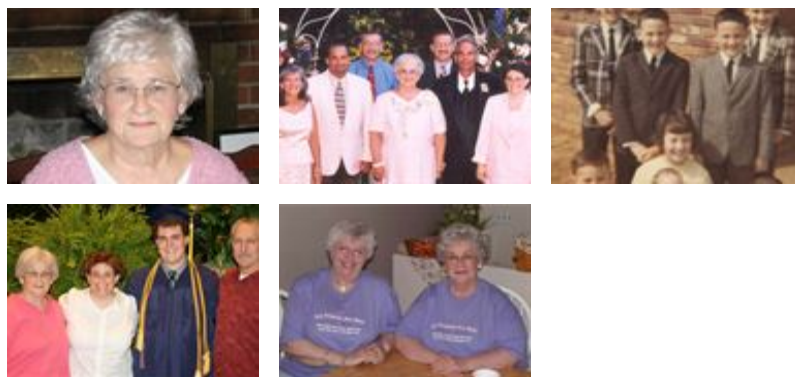
