Billy Ray Wise, 67 years, passed away Friday, August 2, 2013, at Hospice Care Center, St. Joseph Hospital, Lexington, KY.

Services for Mr. Wise will be 10:30 a.m. Tuesday, August 6, 2013, at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home with Rev. Todd Lester officiating. Burial with military honors will be in Valley Cemetery, Taylorsville, KY. Visitation will be 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Monday at the funeral home.
