In lieu of flowers, expressions of sympathy may be made to Bellepoint Baptist Church.

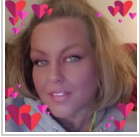

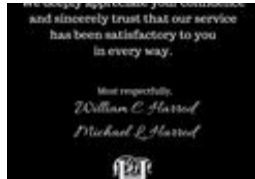

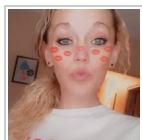
