



Charlann Carroll

September 17, 1932 - September 10, 2014

Charlann Harting Carroll, wife of Former Governor and now State Senator Julian M. Carroll, unexpectedly passed away early Wednesday morning at the University of Kentucky Medical Center. She became ill at home on Monday and was transferred by ambulance to the Frankfort Regional Medical Center and then transported by air to the University of Kentucky Medical Center.

Mrs. Carroll is survived by her husband, Julian M. Carroll and their children, Kenneth Morton Carroll (Virginia), Iva Patrice Carroll and Ellynn Carroll Henderson (Michael). In addition the following grandchildren Michael Daniel Henderson, Christopher Morton Carroll, Niki Eads Carroll, Evelynn Reese Carroll, Jason Thomas Carroll, John Bradley Carroll, Clayton Russell Carroll, Emma Dance Carroll, Robert Samuel Henderson, David Maxwell Henderson and Johnathon Edward Hockensmith. Their son Bradley Harting Carroll (Carla Dance Carroll) preceded his mother.

Mrs. Carroll was 81, born in Paducah, McCracken Co.. Preceded in death by her parents Horace and Iva Harting and one brother Dr. John Earl Harting. This year the Carroll's celebrated their 64th wedding anniversary. The couple attended school together from 2nd grade through High School. In addition they have resided on their family farm in Frankfort since 1984.

Visitation and Funeral will be held at the Forks of Elkhorn Baptist Church, 495 Duckers Rd, off US Highway 421 Frankfort/Midway. Visitation hours will be Friday, from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm and Saturday, from 12:00 pm to 2:00 pm and the funeral will immediately follow.
