Charles Thomas "Chuck" Anglin, 47, passed away Saturday, September 25, 2010 at the University of Kentucky Medical Center, Lexington.

Services for Chuck will be 2:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 29, 2010 at Harrod Brothers Memorial Chapel. Rev. Mr. Tom Snyder will officiate. (Also, Rev. Manns). Burial will follow in the Frankfort Cemetery. Visitation will be 4 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Tuesday at the funeral home.

A native of Frankfort, he was born September 25, 1963. Chuck was a graduate of Good Shepherd School and Frankfort High School. He was a United States Navy veteran and his unit was the first responders to the terrorist attack on the Marine barracks of Beirut, Lebanon. He was a branch manager for the Facilities Management Branch, Kentucky Department of Transportation. He was an avid sportsman, fisherman and hunter. His wish to be an organ donor was honored by his family.

He is survived by his father, Jerry D. (Fran) Anglin; his mother, Ella Ruth Pardi; four brothers, Jeffrey, Anglin, Murfreesboro, TN, David Anglin, Keith Pardi, Maxwell Pardi, all of Frankfort; and his grandmother, Marian Thompson, Loretto, KY.
