Mr. Lawrence was a native and resident of Frankfort, KY and the son of the late Charles Cleveland Lawrence, Sr. and Edith Gordon Lawrence. He was a 1939 graduate of Frankfort High School and a retired employee of the State Finance and Administration Cabinet. Mr. Lawrence served during World War II in the Army Air Force as an airplane bomber mechanic. He was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars #4075, American Legion Post 7, Disabled American Veterans, and the Honorable Order of Kentucky Colonels.

Mr. Lawrence was predeceased by his wife, Dorothy Patrick Lawrence and two sisters, Katherine Lawrence Carter and Tevis Lawrence Cunningham. He is survived by two sons, Richard Cleveland Lawrence and Charles Patrick Lawrence, both of Frankfort.
