Frankfort " Charles Reed Lewis, age 92, passed away peacefully on Friday, September 23, 2016, at St. Joseph Hospice Care in Lexington. Mr. Lewis was born in Frankfort, Kentucky on May 27, 1924 to the late Robert and Rachel Brawner Lewis.
