August 3, 1916 - June 30, 2013

Diana G. Kell, 96, widow of clarinetist, Reginald C. Kell, of Frankfort, Kentucky, passed away June 30, 2013, of pneumonia. She is survived by her only child, Jeff Kell, and four granddaughters, Allison Crume (David), Jessica Faulkner (Brad), Holly Kell, Hillary Kell, and their mother, Margie Kell. She is also survived by four great-grandchildren, Courtney and Chase Crume, and Savannah and Brady Faulkner.

She was born August 3, 1916, in London, England to English composer Josef Holbrooke and his wife Dorothy. Diana and her husband moved to Frankfort, Kentucky in 1978, to be close to her son and his family. A creative person in her own right, she devoted her talents to pottery, sewing, knitting, music writing, macramé and building restoration and remodeling. It was this latter interest, initiated in Aspen, Colorado, in 1957, that consumed most of her attention after her husband passed away in 1981. By the time she had finished, at age 85, she had resurrected nine buildings in the South Frankfort neighborhood. A selfless individual and tireless worker, she devoted her life to her family and the community in which she lived.

The Kell family will receive family and friends at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Wednesday, July 10, from 5 to 7 pm.
