Frankfort" Dorothy (Turner) Brown died at The Beehive on June 11, 2009. She was the daughter of Harold Turner, a railroad telegrapher/ (later) professional fisherman and Elizabeth Turner, RN, the first woman in New York State to run her own hospital.

Mrs. Brown received her RN degree in NY and worked for the Red Cross before relocating to Daytona Beach, where she met and married Lt. Commander, US Navy, Billy B. Brown. During her 48 years of marriage, she was an avid golfer, gardener, a gourmet cook and an artist of needlepointing. National Distillers took her and her husband to Cincinnati, Los Gatos, Memphis and finally, Frankfort where Mr. Brown managed Old Crow, Old Taylor and Old Grandad.

Dorothy Brown is survived by her daughter, Deborah Brown Gould, her grandchildren, Michael Carey Gould and Stephanie Meszaros and her great grandson, William Elbert Gould.
