Lexington " Dr. Joseph Paul Leone passed away Friday, February 8, 2013, at Markey Cancer Center.

Services for Dr. Leone will be 11:00 a.m. Tuesday, February 12, 2013, at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home with Rev. Chuck Ellestad officiating. Burial will follow in Frankfort Cemetery. Visitation will be at the funeral home Monday from 5:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.
