Dr. Geyer (83) passed away at his home June 4, 2013. He was born August 25, 1929 to the late Stanger and Mabel Geyer of Des Moines, IA.

He spent four years in the U.S. Navy and was honorably discharged in 1955.

Upon his return he attended Iowa State University where he earned his Doctor of Veterinary Medicine degree. After college he went to work for the United States Department of Agriculture (U.S.D.A.) Veterinary Services. He resided in several states over the years with the U.S.D.A. but in 1979 he transferred to Kentucky as the Federal Veterinarian in Charge of Animal Disease over the State. Dr. Geyer remained in that position until 1990 when he retired.

In retirement he spent many years traveling and fishing. He was loved by many and respected by all who knew him.

In addition to his wife of 34 years, Shirley, survivors include three sons, Jon Geyer, Des Moines, IA, Eric (Becky) Geyer, Indianapolis, IN, Keith Geyer, Sarasota, FL, two daughters, Janet Warner, Naco AZ and Barbara Fox, Bisbee, AZ, two step children Mike (Amy) Feldman of Frankfort, KY and Marcy (Frank) Thompson, Columbia, MO, sister Linda Myers and sister in law Shirley Geyer, as well as 18 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren. Dr. Geyer was preceded in death by two brothers Bill and Jim Geyer and one daughter Peggy Geyer.
