Elizabeth Susan "Libby" Delong Sammons, age 69, passed away peacefully at home after a three year battle with cancer on Sunday, May 3, 2015.

A Celebration of Life Service will be held at 7:00 p.m. Thursday, May 7, 2015, at Capital City Christian Church with Dr. Steve Pattison officiating. Family and friends will be received at the church prior to the service beginning at 5:00 p.m. An additional Celebration of Life Service will be held at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, May 9, 2015, at the Louisa United Methodist Church with visitation beginning at noon. Interment will follow in Yatesville Memorial Gardens.

A native of Louisa, Kentucky, she was born October 13, 1945. She was the only child of Arvel Delong and the late Garna Sena Manda Rose Delong. She was a retired employee of the Local Health Services Branch, Department of Public Health, Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services and remained a dedicated advocate for public health services. Libby was a devoted member of Capital City Christian Church. She was an avid reader, enjoyed following the UK basketball teams, was a gifted pianist and will be fondly remembered by her many piano students.
