I did get arrested when I left for rehab bc I had probation violation and it killed me shen I found you were gone when I was locked up. It isn't fair that I got to get my life back and you didn't. I have everything back because of you and I will never forget that. I want you to know you was the best thing that ever happened to me. You got me crying right now writing this. I lost all of our pictures of us together on my old phone back then and wish so
Bad I could have atleast have those pictures. You have no idea how much I miss you it's isn't fair you deserve to had this life too with me. Just remember I love you more the you can ever know and will never never forget you. I think about you every single day
