



## Floyd Guy Gilbert

Mr. Gilbert, age 90, passed away at home Friday, December 19, 2014. He was born in Franklin County August 24, 1924, the son of the late Kelly Guy and Mattie Monroe Gilbert. Mr. Gilbert was a World War II veteran serving in the United States Army. He retired from Genesco with 34 years of service and began another career with Kentucky State Government where he was a supervisor in the Department of Finance retiring after 27 years of service.
