Frankfort " Floyd Smith, loving husband of Betty Q. Smith of nearly 57 years and father of Floyd Gregory Smith and Sheila K. Turner passed away Saturday, March 10, 2012 at his home.

Floyd Smith, 92 years, was born in Franklin County, Kentucky (Thornhill) October 31, 1919, one of six children of Lorenzo B. Smith and Pearl Barker Smith.

He is predeceased by both parents and three sisters, Mary Raisor, Thelma Devers and Florence Dykes.

In addition to his wife and children, he is survived by two brothers, M.R. "Russ Smith (Dorothy), Frankfort and Clarence Smith (Mary Lee), Salinas, CA; six grandchildren, Katherine L.
