Frankfort – Theodore Franklin “Frank” Manns, 69 years old, of Frankfort, Kentucky, passed away on Saturday, September 18, 2021. Services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Thursday, September 23, 2021, at 10:30 a.m. with Rev. Mike Napier officiating. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens.
