Frank Wagoner, age 76, passed away Monday, December 17, 2012, at home following a long illness. Services for Mr. Wagoner will be 10:00 a.m. Thursday, December 20, 2012, at Faith Baptist Church with Rev. Bill Perkins and Rev. Everett Hawkins officiating. Visitation will be 4:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. Wednesday at the church.
