Frankfort " Frank Lynn Yeast, 84, passed away February 27th, 2012, at home following a long illness.

Born in Mercer County December 4th, 1927, he was the youngest child of Dan and Mattie Patterson Yeast. Frank graduated from Harrodsburg High School. He entered the United States Army and served in the Military Police as a motorcycle officer, in Trieste, Italy during the Korean War. After his military service, Frank moved to Frankfort and went to work for Kawneer-a factory that made parts for airplanes. He met the love of his life, Janice, in January 1953. Married in August of that year, Frank started working for his brother "Tasty" in the Palm Meat Shop. He worked in his brother's shop for 3 years, then accepted a job with South Central Bell in 1956. Frank retired as a cable repairman after 30 years of service with the company he fondly referred to as "Ma Ding-A-Ling."

A master craftsman, Frank enjoyed working with many friends and relatives to repair and create new projects such as go-carts, unicycles, etc. He was a life member of Hiram Lodge #4F&AM, life member of the VFW, past member of Crestwood Baptist Church and current member of First Baptist Church at the Singing Bridge.
