Frankfort – George Johnson Heady, age 79, passed away Thursday, December 19, 2024. Services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Friday, December 27, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. with Bro. Paul Elswick and Rev. Tim Jumpp officiating. Burial will follow at Sunset Memorial Gardens. Military Honors will be observed at the gravesite by the VFW Post 4075. Visitation will be from 11:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Friday.

Mr. Heady was born in Frankfort, Kentucky on December 30, 1944, to the late Thomas Gilbert Heady and Rosa Bell Monroe Heady. He retired as the Environmental Director from the Franklin County Health Department. Mr. Heady was a Veteran of the United States Air Force and was a member of Christian Assembly Church in Frankfort.

He is survived by his beloved wife 58 years, Jenny Heady; children, Michelle Mills (Mark), Sherri Duplessis (David), and Chris Heady (Yonna); sister, Irene Turner; and by 10 grandchildren, 4 great-grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.
