



## George Raymond Karsner

Mr. Karsner passed away peacefully at his residence on Saturday.

George was born October 23, 1929, in Franklin Co., KY, the only son to the late George Raymond and Lillian Calvert Karsner. He enlisted in the US Army, served during the Korean Era, and retired from the US Army and Ky National Guard as a Chief Warrant Officer 4th Class. He was a charter member of Highland Christian Church, lifetime member of Hiram Lodge #4, Oleika Shrine of Lexington, Scottish Rite, Valley of Lexington, Order of the Eastern Star, and American Legion. During his term as President of the Franklin County Council for Retarded Children, Mr. Karsner was instrumental in forming this organization which received its charter in September 1958. Fudder was an avid UK fan, and while his health allowed, he enjoyed golf and fishing.

Left to mourn his passing are his beloved wife of 65 years, Edna Graham Karsner; son, Lee (Lisa) Karsner; sister, Carolyn K. (the late Kelly) Barker;

grandchildren, Jason, Erich, and Jennifer Karsner; great grandson, Colin; and several nieces and nephews. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by son, Phillip Ray Karsner, and his loving English bulldog, Bandit.
