Glenda Miller, 75, died Wednesday, September 22, 2010. She was born on March 11, 1935 in Lansing, Michigan. She is survived by her husband P. Robert (Bob) Miller, her three children, Terri Gilmore of Shelby County, Mike Miller of Atlanta, Ga., and Christi Hodges of Atlanta, Ga. eight grandchildren; and two sisters, Marlyn Baechler of White Pigeon, Mich. and Charlene Johnson of Marshall, Mich. She started her career 28 years ago in Kentucky state government as an administrative assistant in Governor Julian Carroll's office.
