



## Glenn Michael Davis

Frankfort " Glenn Michael Davis, 66, passed away on Thursday, May 18, 2017. Graveside services for Glenn will be held at Sunset Memorial Gardens on Monday, May 22, 2017, at 3:00 p.m. with Deacon Michael Lynch officiating.

Glenn is the author of "Keeping the Peace - Tales from the Old West," "Love and Danger in the Old West" and "Old West Chronicles." All three books are non-fiction containing stories of legendary old west characters and events. Glenn is a retired U.S. Navy Chief and a Vietnam War veteran. During his career he safeguarded our nation's top military secrets while serving with the Defense Intelligence Agency at the Pentagon. Following his retirement from the Navy, Glenn worked in the private sector in a variety of positions in security management. Most notable of his career experiences would be his work as a Private Investigator and Bail Enforcement Agent where he utilized his skills as a fugitive hunter. In 2016 Glenn appeared giving commentary on the nationally televised program "Tom Smith: The Two-Fisted Marshal of Abilene." The show was part of the American Lawmen series which was produced by Cineflix and appeared on the American Heroes channel. He is a commissioned Kentucky Colonel and a member of the Honorable Order of Kentucky Colonels.

He was the son of the late Kenneth Wesley Davis and Doris Agnes Maloney Davis. Glenn is survived by his wife, Susan Bradley Davis; children, Aaron

Davis (Tracie), Patrick Davis, Christina Papada (Andrew), Jennifer Mills, Meighan Papa, Amy Smith, and Jennifer Robinson; and grandchildren, Maya Papada, Ryan Papada, Graham Papada, Brendan Smith, Alex Papa, and Rachel Davis; sisters, Nora Pawelczak, Kim Dunmire, Susan Smith, and Jan Davis; sister-in-law, Shy Bradley and nephew, Andrew Carter.
