Frankfort – Harold Allen “Red” Sayre, age 84, passed away Saturday, April 21, 2018. Services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home Thursday, April 26, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. with Minister Robert T. Andrews officiating. Burial will follow at Frankfort Cemetery. Military Honors will be observed at the gravesite by the V.F.W. Post 4075. The family will receive friends at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home from 4:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 25, 2018, and 9:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m. service time on Thursday, April 26, 2018.

He was a Veteran of the United States Air Force, serving in Korea as a Prop Instructor and training Japanese pilots. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Clifford Sayre.
