Frankfort " Services for Harry Porter Brundage, 84, of Frankfort, will be conducted from Harrod Brothers Memorial Chapel on Thursday, July 19, 2007 at 2:00 p.m. with burial following at the Frankfort Cemetery.

He died Monday, July 16, 2007 at his residence following an illness.

He was born in Lansing, MI on August 12, 1922, and was raised in Bloomfield, KY where he graduated from Bloomfield High School in 1941. He was a builder, realtor, developer of Spring Hill Estates, and owner of Carriage House Gifts. He was a member of First Christian Church. He was also a member of the VFW Post 4075 and the American Legion Post 7. He was a past member of the East Frankfort Kiwanis.

On his 21st birthday, he voluntarily enlisted to serve his country during World War II. He became a Sergeant in the 8th Division of the Army Air Corps. As a radio operator/mechanic and aerial gunner, he flew 35 missions in Europe. He was honorably discharged from his service in 1945.

The great loves of his life were his family, friends, University of Kentucky football, Detroit Tigers baseball, and fishing.

He is survived by his wife of sixty years, Dorothy Louise Wells Brundage, Frankfort; two daughters, Judy Brundage and Nancy Fuller (Jerry), both of Frankfort; and two grandchildren, Andy Fuller (Becky) and Brandon Fuller, both of Frankfort.

He was the son of the late Harry Porter Brundage and Brooke Muir Duncan. He was also preceded in death by his brother, Richard Brundage.
