Frankfort- Services for Henry Joseph Hall, 85, will be Thursday, 1:30 p.m. at Harrod Brothers Memorial Chapel.

A native of Lexington, he was the son of the late Charles and Callie Tillett Hall.

He served his country as a U.S. Marine Air Corp Corporal during WWII in the South Pacific, as a Sergeant for the Kentucky Highway Patrol, and as an officer with the Frankfort Police Department. He also worked as an agent with Alcohol Beverage Control and was recognized by J. Edgar Hoover for apprehension of a bank robber. He retired as the Superintendent of the State Office Building with twenty-five years of service.

Surrounded by his wife, children and grandchildren, he died at his home on Sunday, October 8, 2006, following a long illness.

Survivors include his wife, Bonnie Hockensmith Hall, with whom he had been married fifty-nine years; his sons, Ronald Joseph Hall (Eva), Lexington, and William Thomas Hall (Jean), Nicholasville; his daughters, Sandra Hall Carlton-McCoy (Butch) and Susan Hall Goddard (Tom), both of Frankfort; a sister, Thelma Hall Devin, Frankfort; nine grandchildren, Edie Jo McClellan (Sean), Carl Perkins (Kathy), Michael Hall (Samantha), Jim Hall (Stacy), Phillip Hall, Will Carlton, John Carlton, Taylor Goddard (Lindsay) and Evan Goddard, and ten great-grandchildren.
