Frankfort" Howard McClain Norrell, 89, died Monday at his home following a long illness. Born in Sugar Valley, Georgia, he was the son of the late Grace McClain and William Seab Norrell. Mr. Norrell was a 1938 graduate of Woodlawn High School in Birmingham, Alabama and received a Bachelor's of Science degree from Howard College. He began his career by working for Genesco Shoe Co. in Nashville, Tennessee, later transferring to Frankfort where he was an executive with General Shoe Company. In 1952, he went into business with his father-in-law operating Jacobs/Norrell Appliances. They also started one of the first television cable companies in the country, Consolidated T.V. Cable Co., which he operated until his retirement in 1992. Mr. Norrell was a Navy veteran of WWII. He was a past member of the East Frankfort Kiwanis Club, the Masons, the American Legion and an active member of the Frankfort Elks Lodge until his death.

He was married to the late Lois Jacobs Norrell. Survivors include two devoted daughters, Suzanne (Randy) Long and Patricia (Robert) Perry; two granddaughters, Dee Dee Pennington and Amy Perry; two brothers, Robert David Norrell of Mission Viejo, California and Joe Bob Norrell of Charleston, South Carolina; one sister, Dorothy Odom, Frankfort, formerly of Birmingham, Alabama; and four great granddaughters.

A memorial service will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home at 7:00 p.m.

Tuesday, June 1, 2010. Chaplain Roger Outler will officiate. Visitation will be Tuesday from 5:00 p.m. until the service at the funeral home.
