Frankfort – Charles Hugh Lounsbury Hudson, III, age 74, passed away at home on Sunday, January 21, 2024. Services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Monday, January 29, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. with Pastor Philip Whitehead officiating. Burial will follow at Frankfort Cemetery.
