April 30, 1919 - November 9, 2017

Hugh L. Hudson, Jr, 98-years, died at the Frankfort Medical Center due to injuries sustained in an auto accident on November 9, 2017, in Frankfort. A widower and the husband of his beloved Dorothy were married on July 27, 1937. The son of Hugh L. Hudson, Sr. and Pauline Boorum Hendrick, he was born in New York, New York on April 30, 1919. He was a graduate of Frankfort High School. He also attended Culver Military School and the University of Kentucky.

He worked at the Frankfort State Journal at the outbreak of World War II when he enlisted in the United States Navy. He spent time in the Pacific Theatre on two LSMs at a radioman 2nd class.

Upon his return to Frankfort he co-owned, with his Dorothy, Hudson & Co., Inc., a woman & child retail store. He is survived by two devoted children, Dorothy Buchanan (Don) and Hugh L. Hudson III; two grandsons, Stephen Switzer (Megan) and Todd Switzer (Cathy); four great-grandchildren, Matthew, Rachael, Mayme and Ann; and his two cats, Mr. Orange and Boots.

He was a proud member of the Frankfort City School Board for eight-years.
