Isaac Gleason, a long-time Frankfort, Kentucky resident, passed away on November 23, 2022, at the age of 45, due to an illness.

He was athletic and played both baseball and basketball growing up, before getting into weight lifting as an adult. He will be deeply missed by his family, friends, and all who knew him.
