Mr. Driskell passed away Thursday, February 2, 2012, at Frankfort Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Driskell served in the United States Air Force during World War II. He was a veteran of the Pacific Area and was on the island of Tinian when the atomic bomb was being assembled.
