Jack H. "Jay" Devers, Jr. was taken home to be with his Lord on November 24, 2009, at his home in Diamond Bar, CA. Born on July 6, 1955 in Frankfort, Kentucky, Jay is survived by his mother Jacqueline Devers, son Jerod, daughter Katie, daughter-in-law Sarah, and girlfriend Annette Gonzalez. He was predeceased in death by his sister Jennifer Devers, brother Jeffrey Devers, father Jack H. Devers, Sr., and grandparents George and Pearl Hoover, and Calvin and Jenova Devers.

Jay graduated from Ganesha High School in Pomona and earned his bachelor's degree at the University of La Verne. He was an administrator and coach at Walnut High School for twenty years and Administrative Director, Auxiliary Services at Mt. San Antonio College for the past seven years. Jay served on the Board of Directors of the Chaffey Federal Credit Union, and was a member of the National Association of College Auxiliary Services, and the National Association of College and University Food Services.

Jay was an avid Mason. His Masonic career began when he joined the Pomona Chapter Order of DeMolay where he later served Master Councilor. Jay belonged to Pomona Lodge #246 F&AM; Pomona Chapter #76 Royal Arch Masons; Pomona Council #21 Cryptic Masons; Southern CA

Jay served with distinction in offices of all these organizations, and was currently serving as the Grand Sentinel of the Grand Council of Cryptic Masons of the State of California.
