He died Thursday, July 5, 2007, quietly at home. He was born in Cairo, IL, on September 24, 1924. On May 24, 1952, he married Barbara Ann Crawford, now Barbara Haworth, who survives him. He is also survived by his daughters, Beverly (Perry) Hytken and Jamie Haworth, his grandson, Brandon Jett and his granddaughter, Hannah Hytken. He was preceded in death by his beloved daughter, Tammie Haworth.

Jim was an Army Veteran of World War II with service in England, France and Germany and was a lifetime member of the VFW Post 4075. He graduated from the University of Kentucky in 1951 with a degree in Civil Engineering and later founded Haworth and Associates Engineering Firm in Frankfort, Ky. He later co-founded the Haworth, Meyer & Boleyn Engineering Firm. He was a registered Professional Engineer in the states of Kentucky, West Virginia, Tennessee and Ohio. Jim served on the Board of Directors of the State National Bank and was a past Director of Big Brothers of Frankfort, the Frankfort YMCA, the Frankfort County Club and Consulting Engineers of

Kentucky.
