James Andrew May, age 86, passed away peacefully at home Friday, April 10, 2015.

Mr. May was born November 16, 1928, in Prestonsburg, KY and was the son of the late Andrew Jackson May Jr. and Bess Salisbury May. He was a 1946 graduate of Kentucky Military Institute. He served in the U.S. Army, both active and reserves, as a 1st Lieutenant and was one of three officers assigned to establish the Floyd County Army Reserve Unit.
