Frankfort – Jan Beatrice Stevens, 76, of Frankfort, Kentucky, passed away peacefully on November 28, 2025, surrounded by her loving family and grandchildren.

Born October 4, 1949, in Council Bluffs, Iowa. Jan graduated from Abraham Lincoln High School in 1967, and earned her Bachelor of Science degree from Baylor University in 1971.
