Frankfort -James Coleman "Jc" Newton, age 62, passed away Saturday, October 19, 2019. A Celebration of Life will be held at Capital City Christian Church on Wednesday, October 23, 2019, at 4:00 p.m. with Rev. Jon Sutphin officiating. The family will receive friends at Capital City Christian Church from 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday.
