Frankfort – Jimmy Tilford Allison, age 74, passed away on Saturday, February 6, 2021. A native of Franklin County, Kentucky, he was preceded in death by his father, James Corbett Allison, his mother, Lura Hockensmith Allison, and his youngest brother, Johnny Lee Allison.
