John Thomas “Johnny” Jordan, III, 78, of Frankfort, Kentucky, went to Heaven on February 1, 2025, with his beloved wife by his side.

He loved and was so proud of his family. He is the son of the late John Thomas “JT” Jordan, Jr. and Mary Louise Jordan. He is survived by his loving wife of 60 years, Patricia Kay “Patty” Jordan, and identical twin sons, “the boys,” Michael John Jordan (Anne) and Donald Shawn Jordan (Amy). After selling the business, Johnny then went to work for Malone & Hyde, a large grocery distributor, which eventually gave him the opportunity to open his first grocery store, Jordan’s Pic-Pac on Second Street, where he had an impact on many lives of those who worked and shopped at the store.

Johnny loved Southern Gospel music and was a member of the original Mel-O-Tones Quartet along with his father JT, and he also was a member of The

Followers quartet. He loved watching Gaither videos and singing with friends. Johnny knew Jesus personally and was confident in where he will spend eternity. He was a member of Forks of Elkhorn Baptist Church. He was generous and impacted the lives of so many.

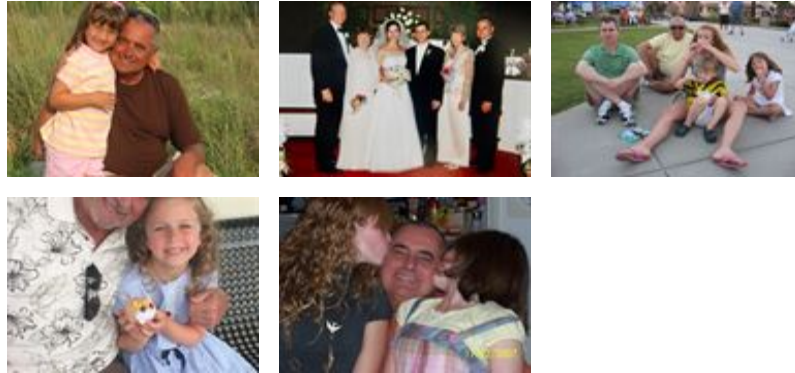
