Frankfort – Joshua David Gregory, a native of Georgetown, passed away on Friday, May 10, 2019, in Frankfort. He was 42 years old.

Joshua was born in Lexington, but at a young age moved with his family to a farm next to the Elkhorn Creek in Scott County. A graduate of Scott County High School, Joshua excelled in art and continued his arts education at Columbus College of Art and Design in Columbus, Ohio.

Joshua was a young man of enormous creative talent. Although a professional cabinetmaker by trade, he was also an accomplished outdoorsman, gardener, cook, artist, photographer, and musician. Joshua had an unquenchable thirst for knowledge and an avid curiosity about the world. He possessed a kind, introspective nature and loved nothing more than discussing the mysteries of life while sitting around a campfire or paddling a quiet stretch of water.

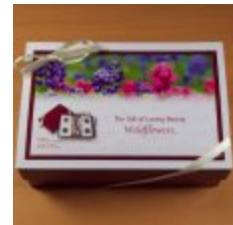
