When the distillery was sold to Sazerac, she decided to become a restaurant owner and opened the Eastside Diner and served the public for almost 20 years.

In those 20 years, she made many lifelong friends. Unknown to many, was how she made sure she people that were having a hard time were fed and taken care of at her expense. Seeing this, the customers started to help too. Eastside Diner was a place of happiness and friendliness. It was an awarded

restaurant of the year for two straight years. Judy will be missed by her many friends and associates.

She is survived by her loving husband, Joseph Darmand; son, Shawn K.
