Frankfort - Services for Lawrence Edwin Watson, 86, will be conducted from First Baptist Church at 7pm Tuesday, April 21, 2015, with Dr. Bob Browning and Dr. David Hinson officiating. Mr. Watson passed away Friday, April 17, 2015, at UK Hospital, Lexington.

Born January 16, 1929, in Ashland, KY, Lawrence was one of five children. He enlisted and served three years with the U.S. Army. He married Mary Anna Parker Watson and they celebrated 63 years of marriage. He directed the Senior Golf program at Juniper Hills, was a member of Central Kentucky Senior Men's Golf League, and was an active golfer at the time of his passing. Mr. Watson was a member of First Baptist Church where he served as Deacon, Deacon Emeritus, and taught Sunday School. He was a former member of the Kiwanis Club and Telephone Pioneer Association. He volunteered and was actively involved with the Soup Kitchen. He enjoyed fishing with his children and grandchildren.
