Frankfort – Lewis Clay Goins, age 72, passed away on Wednesday, February 22, 2023. A gathering of family and friends will be held on Monday, February 27, 2023 from 5:00 p.m. until 7:00 p.m. at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home. A private entombment will be held at Camp Nelson National Cemetery.
