Frankfort " On Monday, October 18, 2010, Marsha Ann Barker Walters, 39, died at the Frankfort Regional Medical Center. Born March 5, 1971, in Frankfort, KY, she was a 1989 graduate of Western Hills High School, attended Eastern Kentucky University and a graduate of Sullivan University. She received her Certified Public Manager's Certificate from Kentucky State University. She was an employee of the Commonwealth of Kentucky for 19 years, she served in both Medicaid and the Cabinet for Health and Family Services and was currently an Internal Policy Analyst with the GAPS Shared Services Division of Budgets.

She was a member of the Memorial Baptist Church and the AGAPE Sunday School class. She was actively involved with the youth, Upward program, and participated in the church's missionary programs including: Connections, Lynch, and numerous children's programs.
