Long time Frankfort Attorney, Marvin Coles, 82 passed away peacefully at his home on July 19, 2022. He is survived by his wife of 54 years, Betty Sue Roberts Coles, his son David and daughter-in-law, Barbara, his beloved grandchildren, Olivia, Caroline and Mary Claire, step grandchildren, Tony, Nick, and Lora Stone, and his sister-in-law and brother-in-law Mary Lou and Butch Yeary. He had six cousins. He was predeceased by his parents Edith Coles Howard and Willard Coles. He was a member of First Baptist Church. Marvin graduated from the University of Kentucky and received his Juris Doctorate Degree in 1965 and began 54 years of private law practice. Over that time his associates included Marion Rider, William L. Brooks, Edward F. Prichard, William Graham, James Boyd, James Hudson, Allen Prewitt and Andrew Bowker.
