Mary passed away peacefully at Memorial Hospital West in Pembroke Pines, FL on Thursday, September 25, 2008.

A native of Prestonsburg, KY, she was born February 2, 1957. (Graham, please include any information about her Frankfort years.)

Following her service in the US Navy as a petty officer, including service as one of the first women ever to be given a billet on a US Navy vessel as an electronics technician, and her service with the Dept of the Army again as an electronics tech, she was an Occupational Hygienist and an 11(c) investigator in the Cincinnati area office before accompanying her husband, Graham, in a work related relocation to Antwerp in Belgium. Upon their return, she was a health and safety inspector in the Ft Lauderdale, OSHA area office for several years before accepting a position in The Dept. of Labor in Washington DC and from which you took early retirement last year.

Mary is survived by her husband, Graham Anderson and her sister, Chadie Salisbury Fruehwald.

She was the daughter of the late Jack Salisbury and Margaret Fincel Salisbury.

Visitation will be Saturday from 12:00 to 1:00 p.m. at the funeral home.
