August 30, 1960 - October 5, 2018

Frankfort – Michael Lee Fint, age 58, passed away at home on Friday, October 5, 2018. Born August 30, 1960, in Frankfort to the late Chester O. and Ollie Frances Jackson Fint, he was a 1978 graduate of Franklin County High School and retired from the Kentucky State Police in 2008 with 22 years of service as a dispatcher. He was a lifelong dedicated member of Bethel Baptist Church, having served as a deacon, trustee, and treasurer, and was commissioned as a Kentucky Colonel.
