January 15, 1947 - July 29, 2025

Frankfort – Mike Sebastian, 78, passed away on July 29, 2025, at Frankfort Regional Medical Center following a sudden illness.

Services will be held at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home on Wednesday, August 6, 2025, at 2:00 p.m. with Dr. Jack Brewer officiating. Visitation will be at Harrod Brothers Funeral Home from 11:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday.

Born on January 15, 1947, in Kenton County, Mike was the son of Wilson Sebastian and Eula Mae Bowling Sebastian. He was a proud graduate of Simon Kenton High School (Class of 1965) and went on to earn a Bachelor's degree in English from the University of Kentucky in 1969. His passion for education and service led him to a 15-year career teaching English and coaching at Twenhofel Junior High, Scott High School, and Simon Kenton High School in Kenton County.

Mike's commitment to service extended beyond the classroom. He joined the Army National Guard on May 5, 1971, and served part-time while continuing his teaching career. In 1984, he transitioned to full-time work with the National Guard and spent the next 23 years rising through the ranks, ultimately retiring in 2007 as a Colonel after 35 years of service.

A lover of adventure, Mike cherished his cruise vacations, often traveling with his wife, Patti, and their close-knit group of friends. He was an avid golfer, spending many hours enjoying the company of friends at the Frankfort Country Club. Mike was also a devoted University of Kentucky basketball fan

and proudly rooted for the Cincinnati Reds, never forgetting his Northern Kentucky roots, especially his love for Skyline Chili.

Mike was preceded in death by his parents, his brother, Wilson Sebastian II, and a grandson, Jay.

He is survived by his wife of 44 years, Patti; sons, Joshua and Michael; daughter, Erica; nine grandchildren, one great-grandchild, and a wide circle of extended family and friends who will miss his sharp wit, generous heart, and unwavering loyalty.

Mike's life was a testament to the values of service, friendship, and love of family. He will be deeply missed.

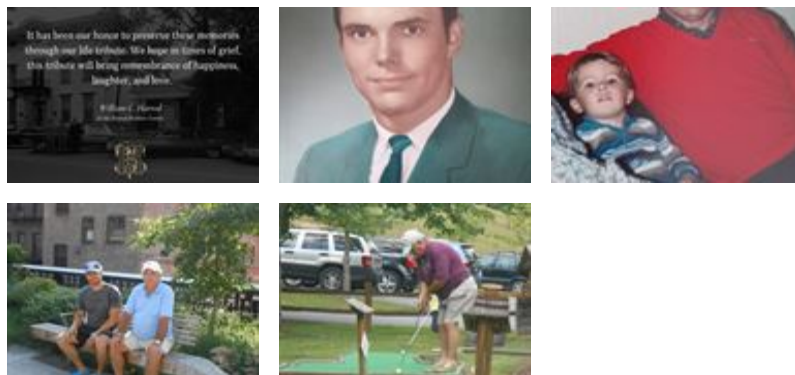
