July 2, 1934 - December 21, 2023

Frankfort – Noel Wise, age 89, passed away at home on Thursday, December 21, 2023. He was born on July 2, 1934, to the late Eugene and Lorena Hukill Wise. One of four boys, he attended what he called “The University of Peaks Mill,” where he played basketball and graduated in 1952. He took a job with the Kentucky State Police in the fall of 1956, as a Trooper assigned to Bullitt County. He was later assigned to Shelby County and Franklin County, where he retired in 1982. His true love was farming, especially raising tobacco. He loved basketball, tennis, horseshoes, ping pong, and pool. He enjoyed dirt track racing at the old Frankfort Speedway and seldom missed a Sunday Stockcar race on TV.

He was a committee member for Farm Service Agency, Outstanding Cooperator of Franklin County Conservation, District Farm Bureau Director, chairman of Southern States Board, and served on the Burley Advisory Council and also a member of KSPPA.

He is survived by his wife, Susan; son, Richard Hanly (Sara); daughters, Vickie Moore (Wayne) and Roseanne Wise; grandchildren, Micah and Zella Jones; Stacey Otero (Mike), Dana Hicks (Chris); and great-grandchildren, Caty and Emily Otero, and Kayla and Zach Hicks.
