A native of Frankfort, she was born February 5, 1931 to the late Lebus and Susan Frenchie Pence Harrod. She received her Registered Nurse designation from Kentucky Baptist Hospital in Louisville. She was later employed by and promoted to accident and health claim manager for the Western Division of American Mutual Insurance Company. In this capacity, she was responsible for the activities of the A&H claim function in the payment of group claims and the servicing of group A&H policyholders in a 20-state area. After her tenure with American Mutual Insurance, she returned to Frankfort and worked as a nurse for HCA-Kings Daughters Hospital. At her retirement, she was a nurse in Turning Point at Frankfort Regional Medical Center.

She was a member of The Episcopal Church of the Ascension where she was active in the Monday Group, and member of the Democratic Women's Club

and Insurance Women's Club
