Born October 20, 1940 in Franklin County, she began her career in the offices of Gov. A. B. Chandler, and held other state government positions, including Legislative Research Commission, and the offices of Gov. Wendell H. Ford. She retired from the Federal Government as a District Manager for U.S. Senator Wendell Ford. She was a member of Buck Run Baptist Church.

She is survived by her loving husband, Earl T. Gregory; her daughter, Jennifer Gregory (Rusty) Ashcraft, Frankfort; and three grandchildren, Taylor Wilkinson, SRMA Lane Wilkinson and Russell Ashcraft.

She was the daughter of the late George McKendrick and Emma Bell Smith and was also preceded in death by her sister, Jeanie Colston and her

grandmother, Nannie (Nanu)Smith.
